Second Consultation paper on EURIBOR

- In October 2018, the **second stakeholder consultation paper** presented a summary of EMMI's findings during the hybrid EURIBOR testing phase, and provided details on EMMI's proposals for the different methodological parameters.
 - The consultation period closed on 30th November 2018;
 - We received 37 responses from a range of institutions (banks, trade) associations, infrastructure providers, consultancy firms, etc.)



Second Consultation paper on EURIBOR



- The consultation sought the markets' opinion on:
 - The aggregated anonymized indicators that EMMI should publish, following the implementation of the hybrid methodology;
 - Eligibility criteria for contributors' transactions to be considered as input for the first hybrid methodology levels;
 - The calibration parameters of the hybrid methodology second level.

EMMI received broad support for the proposals put forward, full details can be found on the <u>Feedback Summary paper</u> published on EMMI's website.
